DIRECTIONS

- From points north Exit I-95 at Indrio road and go East to US 1. Take US1 South and turn left on Seaway Drive. Go over the Intercoastal Waterway to 1120 Seaway Drive.
- From points South Exit I-95 at Okeechobee road, Route 70 and go east on Okeechobee. To stay on Okeechobee Rd bear left at the fork of the road (4th stop light from the 95 exit. Continue east (Okeechobee Rd will turn into Delaware Ave at 17th St) to US 1. Take US 1 North and turn right on Seaway Drive (7th stop light from the intersection of US 1 and Delaware Avenue.) Go east over the Intercoastal Waterway to 1120 Seaway Drive. Turn left at the stoplight. This is the Pelican Yacht Club
- From Florida Turnpike exit at Okeechobee road, Route 70 and go east on Okeechobee. To stay on Okeechobee Rd bear left at the fork of the road (6th stop light from the Turnpike exit. Continue east (Okeechobee Rd will turn into Delaware Ave at 17th St) to US 1. Take US 1 North and turn right on Seaway Drive (7th stop light from the intersection of US 1 and Delaware Avenue.) Go east over the Intercoastal Waterway to 1120 Seaway Drive. Turn left at the stoplight. This is the Pelican Yacht Club.
